His support of the arts led to his involvement with the Museum of Fine Arts, Houston, the Meadows Museum at SMU, the National Gallery of American Art and the Smithsonian in Washington D.C. Using selections from his own extensive collection, Frank helped create Strake Jesuit Art Museum in Houston and Jesuit Dallas Museum as a way to expose young people to quality works of art and foster a new generation of art admirers. This exhibition honors Frank's legacy of philanthropy: proceeds from sales will be donated to charities that he supported.
